



VOLUNTEERING WITH ANIMAL BALANCE

Thank you for your interest in volunteering for Animal Balance. Please visit our website for current campaign dates.

Our strategy: Together with local partners, we create community-based, sustainable humane animal management programs on islands globally.

Who we look for:

Compassionate individuals who have experience in taking exceptional care of animals in high volume, high-quality clinic settings. We recruit by campaign and our volunteer needs change with each island we visit, we normally look for veterinarians and veterinary technicians.

How to apply:

Upon deciding your campaign of interest, please visit our website and click on the 'Volunteer' page. From here complete and submit our [Application Form](#). We will contact you to schedule an interview should there be an available position on your preferred campaign. A team of volunteers will be selected at the end of the interviewing process for each campaign. If you are not selected, please do not be discouraged from re-applying for future campaigns, as our volunteer needs change throughout the year*.

What to expect:

An incredibly rewarding experience with like-minded, compassionate individuals that will do everything they can to help the animals in the communities we visit. Animal Balance volunteers work long hours, we begin and end each day as a team, with each team member being equally responsible for both animal care as well as the sometimes less glamorous jobs of clinic set-up and cleaning. We travel to some of the most beautiful places on the planet and are extremely fortunate to meet inspiring local people and as well as having the privilege of helping these communities take care of their animals.

What is asked of you?

To allow our resources to go towards supplies for our campaigns, we ask that volunteers pay their own flights. Where possible, Animal Balance will try to source donated or low-cost accommodation in the places we visit.

We will help arrange airport pick-ups for when you arrive to help you get to where you need to be. We will also provide you with detailed instructions to help prepare for your travels.

When we travel to islands to which we are unable to ship our supplies, we do ask that volunteers help us carry in these supplies. We also have a small packing list of items that we request our volunteers have to help ensure the smooth running of the campaign.

We ask that you adhere to all of our Standard Operating Procedures; these ensure both the animals' and our team's health and safety.

We look forward to having you join us on one of our campaigns and thank you for your interest and support of Animal Balance's work.
